

Creative Workshop Hosts

Opportunity

Kinning Park Complex are seeking 16 Glasgow based workshop hosts to work on a programme of peer learning and co delivery. These are part of a series of multidisciplinary workshops to kick start creativity back in our recently refurbished building. We are looking to match 8 early career creatives with 8 experienced creatives to co deliver each other's workshops.

Aim

To provide a programme of quality and diverse workshop opportunities to our community whilst giving a space for local creatives to learn from each other and give guidance for those who have little experience in delivering workshops.

Creative Disciplines

We are keen to hear from creatives involved in visual art, craft, design, wellbeing, writing, music, dance and theatre, and propose to match similar disciplines together.

Expectations

- Attending a training session on how to deliver a community workshop - 2 hours, date TBC.
- Ability to work in an allocated pair to support the other practitioner.
- Preparing & planning your workshop including discussions with your partner - 6 hours
- Delivery of your workshop - 2 - 3 hours
- Co Delivery of your partner's workshop - 2 - 3 hours
- Communication with your partner and the project manager.

Further Details

- Audience – KPC community members from a wide range of backgrounds
- Numbers – 8 - 20 depending on what activity is being delivered.
- Time – 2 - 3 hour workshop.

- When – Tuesday afternoons or Thursday before or after our Community Pay What You Can Café.

Fee

- Early Career Workshop Hosts £400 (no experience or under 3 years)
- Experienced Creative Workshop Hosts £600 (over 3 years experience)
- Material budgets available if required, depending on workshop format.
