Role Purpose: To support the running of the kitchen area during Kinning Park Complex Community Meals

Reports to: KPC staff member / Volunteer leader

Location: Kinning Park Complex, 43 Cornwall Street, Glasgow, G41 1BA

Who we are looking for:

- Someone with the basic understanding about personal hygiene while cooking
- Someone willing to work as part of a team, mainly others volunteers
- Someone who can volunteer at least one Monday a month

It would be helpful if:

- You have a current food hygiene certificate at Level 2 or Level 3, or you are willing to volunteer to complete / attend the training course (paid by KPC)
- You have experience cooking with other people in a kitchen

Kitchen Duties

There are many tasks in the kitchen where you can meet new people and learn new skills:

- Kitchen porter - washing and drying plates and kitchen equipment
- Food prep - chopping and assorting ingredients for the days menu
- Cook assistant - helping the chef to cook the days menu
- Cleaning - helping with the clean down

If you have any other suggestions, let your volunteer leader know and we can discuss other ways you might be able to help out.

General Duties

- Contribute to a positive environment by demonstrating: an enthusiastic attitude, respect & patience for others, positive language and team working
- Complete tasks alongside other volunteers as a team or / and on your own
- Contribute ideas to help KPC grow by offering your own feedback and suggestions
- Identify your own training gaps and seek opportunities to learn

- Follow the practices, policies and Health & Safety guidelines in the Volunteer Handbook
- Play an active part in achieving consistent high standards of care: ensuring community members are treated with compassion, dignity and respect

What we offer:

- Support from an experienced team during training and community meals
- Level 2 Food Safety and Hygiene certificate
- Kitchen clothing / aprons, shoes may also be provided (please discuss with us)
- Travel costs (please discuss with us)
